It represents European scientists of all disciplines (including social sciences and the humanities), in the public sector, universities, research institutes, as well as industry and business. It is a **grass-roots** organisation, welcoming membership of research professionals, science-managers, policy-makers, teachers, PhD students, post-docs, industrialists, media correspondents, etc.

A central objective of EUROSCIENCE is to strengthen **relations between science and technology and society**, and to promote Science with the public, industrialists and politicians. EUROSCIENCE provides open fora on topical issues such as *the accountability of scientists to society, the image of science at large, science ethics, scientific policy-making, responsibility towards developing countries...*

EUROSCIENCE works alongside the scientific institutions, learned societies... **to help define the future of Science and Technology in Europe**. Conferences, workshops and other appropriate actions (including Awards) throughout Europe deal with such subjects as *The Future of Young Scientists in Europe, Women in Science, Practical Ways to Integrate East European Research Communities, Technology Transfer, Defining Effective Research-Based Strategies for Responding to Societal and Economic Demands...* Other areas are developed in response to members' suggestions. In August 2004, Euroscience organises in Stockholm the first pan-European Forum on the Sciences - "**EuroScience Open Forum**"

EUROSCIENCE aims **to extend its influence on European authorities and assemblies, governments and parliaments**, and provide an expert base for European Science and Technology policy-makers, working towards an enlarged Science Research area covering all of Europe, from the West to the East.
